We want to make health research easier to understand.



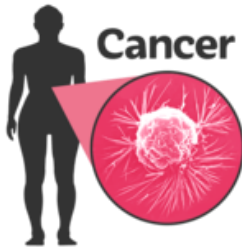
This project will start in February 2023.

One study is about football and brain disease.



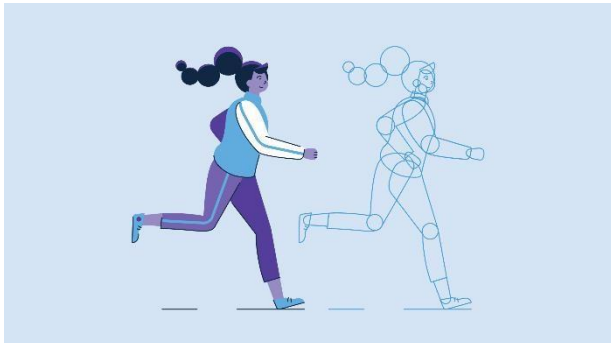
We will hold workshops to co-create the outputs.

3. We will make a podcast to hear what the research is about.



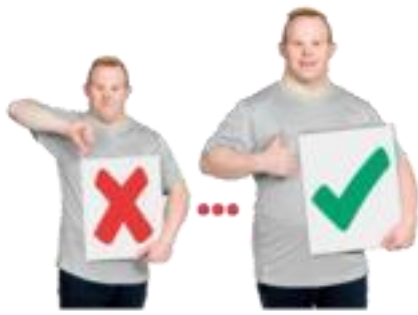
We will share these on our website and social media.
